Provided or supervised over 10,500 contacts with veterans, and secured over \$300,000 in training funds.

Implementation of a theoretically based system of vocational interventions to patients at the Kansas City Veterans Administration Medical Center. Worked full-time during the summer and fall at the V.A., at first helping them develop their vocational rehabilitation program, then turning my attention to trying to understand how the veterans gain entry into the VR system and utilize vocational resources. I saw patients from inpatient psychiatry wards, medical and surgical wards, and the outpatient mental health clinic, but spent most of my time with patients being treated for substance abuse. I offered workshops on vocational services to the staff, and consulted with medical and administrative staff on specific patients as well as on the services available. Before the end of the sabbatical period, I secured funding at about \$50,000 per year for four doctoral students in Counseling Psychology to provide services at the VA under my supervision. This arrangement lasted through 1999 with over \$300,000 in grants to KU and generous funding for 14 different students.
