THE UNIVERSITY OF KANSAS

PURPOSE

The "Sport Skills and Fitness School" is designed to provide boys and girls with the opportunity to develop sports skills and a good cardiovascular fitness level. Experiences will be provided in a conducive to personalized and individualized instructional environment with expert leadership and supervision. The curriculum will consist of a planned program of physical activity including tumbling, aquatics, soccer, archery, tennis, and physical fitness.

Groups will be formed initially by age. 5-6 year olds 7-8 year olds 9-10 year olds 11-12 year olds

TIME SCHEDULE

There will be two exciting sessions. Session #1 will be from June 8--June 26, 2009, Session #2 will be from July 6--July 24, 2009. Each session will run Monday-Friday from 1:00-4:15 p.m.

REGISTRATION

The enrollment for the school is limited to students 5 to 12. The fee for session #1 is \$175.00 and may be paid at one time or in three installments of \$75.00, \$50.00, and \$50.00 each due on April 3, May 8, and June 8, 2009. The fee for session #2 is \$175.00 and may be paid at one time or in three installments of \$75.00, \$50.00, and \$50.00 on May 1, June 5, and July 6, 2009. Fees for each session include instruction, plus two lettered shirts.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

To participate, each student must bring a permit (one used by the doctor) signed by his/her family doctor. This must be turned in by the first day of the session.

INSURANCE

The policy of the University is not to provide insurance. Parents must make individual arrangements.

EQUIPMENT

Each student must supply his/her own swimsuit, towel, athletic socks, gym bag, tennis shoes, and tennis racket. Two lettered shirts will be provided to each student.

FEE REFUND

Requests for refunds must be made prior to May 1, 2009 for the first session and June 5, 2009 for the second session. No more than 75% of the total fee (\$175.00) can be refunded.

LOCATION AND TRANSPORTATION

The Sport Skills and Fitness will be conducted on The University of Kansas campus utilizing the facilities of the Health, Sport, and Exercise Sciences Department. All facilities would be utilized within the guidelines and policies of the HSES Department. Air-conditioned Robinson Center will be available for all indoor tumbling, physical fitness activities, and indoor sport activities.

Parents will be expected to make arrangements for their children's transportation to and from the University facilities each day. Housing facilities will not be provided for student's participation in the school.

Students picked up at 4:15 daily.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Health, Sport, and Exercise Sciences offers an undergraduate and graduate curriculum for men and women who want to earn a teaching certificate in physical education or health education. Sport Science students fill the positions in community and private health, and fitness agencies. The department's facilities include many gymnasiums, swimming pools, classrooms, and research laboratories for exercise physiology, motor development, and biomechanics.
